


Growth Mindsets for All



This workshop examines student motivation and achievement, how this relates to beliefs students hold about themselves and the nature of their ability and how this interacts with teachers beliefs about ability. Find out ways of changing a 'can't do' attitude to a 'can do' one.

The workshop will:

Equip you with a good understanding of the rationale and research evidence from behind two contrasting pupils mindsets

- Explore practical strategies, tools, and resources which will enable you to develop growth mindsets amongst pupils, encouraging them to persist when facing challenge
- Explore activities that help teachers and TAs develop their own growth mindsets and model such attitudes for pupils
- Support you in planning how to change things back in school
